

# Scarborough North Cliff Golf Club

## Return to Golf under COVID-19 Restrictions



Our priority during this time is to ensure as far as possible, the safety and wellbeing of all our members and staff. We would therefore ask members to assist us by adhering to the following guidelines when booking tee times and visiting the Club.

### **Tee Booking**

- Booking a Tee time in advance is compulsory. If you are unable to access BRS then please call us to book a time for you.
- Tee times can be booked up to 10 days in advance.
- Tee times are at 8 minute intervals to maintain social distancing.
- Playing groups should be pre-arranged, roll ups are not permitted.
- The names of all players should be entered into the system for contact tracing purposes.

### **On Arrival at the Club**

- The Clubhouse and Pro's Shop will remain closed so please do not arrive more than 15 minutes before your tee time and ensure you arrive dressed ready for play.
- Equipment should be collected from the Locker room/Trolley Shed on your first visit and taken home following your game as access will be restricted to toilet facilities only until 12th April.
- If you do need to go in to the locker room/toilet area then a face covering must be worn.
- Buggies/Trolleys will be available for Hire for single person use only and will be sanitised accordingly after use.
- Priority on the putting green will be given to the players in the next group due to tee off.
- The Practice Ground can be pre-booked on an hourly basis.
- Tee off times must be strictly observed.

### **During your round**

- Remember to maintain social distancing and remain 2 meters apart at all times, especially on tees and greens. Please also remember this if you see any of our Greenkeepers and allow them to do their job safely.
- Do not touch any golf balls or equipment that does not belong to you.
- Rakes will be removed and bunkers should be smoothed using your club and/or feet.
- Flagsticks will remain in the holes (with the exception of the putting green), and should not be touched.
- Hole cups will be fitted upside down to prevent the ball fully dropping and where possible Flagsticks will be fitted with ball lifters, which should only be lifted using your putter head.
- Ball washers will be out of use and covered over.
- Players must refrain from Handshakes etc.

### **Following your round**

- Social Distancing must be maintained so for the time being we would ask that you kindly leave the Course and car park area immediately following your round to prevent gatherings.
- Players should notify the Club of any post-round COVID-19 related symptoms at the earliest opportunity.

Takeaway food will be available on Saturday & Sunday from 7am to 12noon but it must be taken onto the course or eaten away from the premises.
